The American Institute of Architects (AIA) was created in 1857. Through education, government advocacy, community redevelopment, and public outreach activities, the AIA works towards a public environment that is responsive to the people it serves while representing the professional interest of Americas architects. In close cooperation with other members of the design and construction team, the AIA also works to fulfill its commitment to help coordinate the building industry.

Non-architect **individuals** may join the AIA as Allied Affiliate members. These are **individuals** whose professions are related to the building and design community, such as engineers, landscape architects, or planners; or senior staff from development, building and design related companies (contractors, interior designers) including publishers, product suppliers, product manufacturers, and research firms.

There has been considerable interest shown by many of the ‘Allied’ companies and corporations within the building industry to become allied affiliate members of the AIA at the **company** level rather than at the **individual** level. This interest has expanded beyond passive membership of the individual allied affiliate members. Many allied affiliates who regularly attend the local chapter architectural meetings are requesting that their companies and larger corporate groups be included and represented, and given the opportunity for participation at a technical and social level with the member architects.

This interest is warmly welcomed by member architects of the Chapter and has lead to this offering of application for Allied Affiliate membership of the AIA at the **Company** level.

The benefits of membership at this level are obvious – not only creating vital communication between owners, developers, builders, suppliers and the design teams within the industry, but disseminating knowledge and ideas that can streamline the processes we deal with during creation of our projects.
